"We are taking the right step with this project," says Buderus Guss Managing Director Christoff Wachendorff at the official kick-off for the fire station at the Breidenbach site.

For the plant fire brigade, the multi-million investment is an important step within the framework of the safety concept. The building is state of the art, in compliance with occupational health and safety regulations, and ensures that all fire service procedures and requirements can be met and, above all, that there is space for a

complete crisis team. The central location directly at the factory entrance ensures short distances for the emergency services coming from outside in case of an emergency. The technical and social rooms can accommodate 62 firemen and 10 firewomen. Thanks to the emergency power generator, the fire station is completely self-sufficient in the event of a power failure. The positive side effect of the location: the building forms additional noise protection for the immediate neighbourhood.

After extensive planning, preparations for the construction of the new fire station began in November 2022. The ground-breaking ceremony on 23 February 2023 marked the official start and the base of the Buderus Guss works fire brigade will be completed by the beginning of 2024 at the latest.
